Scholarship

ASCT has posted on their website that their 2012-2013 scholarship application will be coming out on February 6th. For returning families and our new families that have never received scholarship funds from ASCT in the past—this one is huge! This particular STO is a NEEDS-BASED program and is based upon income and size of family. Most importantly, rewards are considered on a first come-first serve basis. Please go at ASCT.org online and print a copy of the scholarship on February 6th. You may also pick up an application in the TCS office at that time. The application will have very specific details as to the steps required to apply. Do take the time to read through the application before completing as some of the guidelines may have changed from previous years. Failure to properly complete and send the required documents could result in denial of funds. As a reminder—before sending to ASCT, you'll need to send the application to TCS to certify that your child is enrolled for the fall 2012-2013 school year. Bottom-line, if you meet their criteria and are fortunate to receive funds, you could end up having 100% of your tuition paid in full for the 2012-2013 school year (combined with CSF funds). It is not guaranteed, but your chances are increased greatly based upon the timing of receipt of your application in their office!

The gym was decorated with pandas and bamboo, and Mr. Maestri dressed up in many costumes to engage the students. Lots of information was given to the students; all of which is in the Bowl-a-thon packets which went home with the students yesterday. In the packets, you will find the following:

- **Parent Letter ~ "Get Ready for PANDAMANIA"**
This outlines the Bowl-a-thon goal of raising \$15,000 ~ all going towards keep tuition rates low; the prizes for raising money; a \$50 minimum pledge total to bowl; a classroom competition description; and the tools included in the Bowl-a-thon packet.
- **Prize Sheet**
This colorful sheet outlines the prizes for different monetary levels of raising pledges.
- **Student Script**
This gives your student an idea of what to say when they are collecting pledges. Students can simplify this so that they can tell it in their own words.
- **Pledge Sheet (Sponsor Sheet)**
Students take this with them when they collect pledges. Please make sure that everything is PRINTED legibly on the form.
- **Sponsor Letter**
These letters, signed by you and/or your student, can be copied and sent out to people to whom you wish to ask for pledges.
- **Special Business Letter**
This letter and form (stapled together) can be given to businesses for which you would like to ask for sponsorships. It outlines the many benefits that the businesses receive when they sponsor a full team or a half team and purchase advertising.
- **2012 Bowl-a-thon Pledge Collection Dates**
This sheet tells you which dates pledges can be brought to the TCS gym. Pledges can only be brought in on these days to the gym. *Pledge money is not to be given to the teachers or the office at any time.*
- **Class Color**
This tells you what color t-shirt your student will wear to the Bowl-a-thon.
